


Trait

Affects about 1 in 10 of those with African ancestry in the USA

Sickle Cell Trait

- Someone with sickle cell trait
 has only 1 out of 2 genes that
 code for sickle cell
 hemoglobin.
- They are a carrier for sickle cell disease.
- Having "trait" does not produce symptoms.
 It is **NOT** the same as sickle cell disease.
- People with sickle cell trait will never get the disease, but they carry a gene that could result in having a child with sickle cell disease.
